What makes InVu your aesthetic bracket of choice?

If bite and function is what you want corrected, then choosing a fixed orthodontic appliance is the better way to go. InVu brackets allow me the same level of control I expect from a traditional twin bracket. If a patient has normal arches, in my opinion InVu brackets treat faster than other bracket systems I have used. Brackets are my preferred aesthetic treatment option because I do not lose rotational control – InVu Aesthetic Brackets work in three planes of space.

What do your patients have to say about InVu?

I've had patients, immediately after bonding, say they cannot see the brackets on their teeth. Parents of adolescents like the predictability of outcome that InVu Aesthetic Brackets provide, and their kids like their smile.

What are your top three reasons for choosing InVu?

- When considering aesthetic treatment options, patients are quick to focus on the appliances themselves, but don't look toward the finish. The bite supports the aesthetics of the end goal – a wonderful smile. If the occlusion is not detailed finely, something will always be off. InVu Aesthetic Brackets give me the detail I expect.
- I treat with clear aligners as well. As we know, the patient always makes the final choice. When they ask the difference between modalities, I say, "Do you want your treatment to be good, better, or best?" If we treat with InVu, you do this [treatment] once and have it done. In my opinion, aligners have a long way to go to be as exacting as a bracket.
- *Personalized Color-Matching Technology* – no other bracket has this ability to blend with multiple shades of tooth enamel. The versatility this allows me in providing unparalleled aesthetic options is paramount.
